




of the Court is required for a transfer of percentage ownership between parties unless it "...disturbs the Status Quo..." As the transfer does not change any material issue other than increasing Ford's already majority ownership to 100%, there was no perceived need for prior approval.

However, as Plaintiff counsel disagrees, counsel here now seeks to clarify or amend the Order to reflect the change in percentage. Plaintiff cannot assert any prejudice from this non-material change as Ford was already the majority owner and the change in title only reflects what was true at the time of the Status Quo agreement.

Further, Ford requests a hearing.




By order of this Court and agreement between the Parties, Plaintiffs Florence and Jack Swaters and Defendants Lawson and Ford, their respective agents, servants, representatives, and attorneys, and all persons acting in aid of or in conjunction or in concert with them, or any of them, and all others whom knowledge or notice of this Order shall come, are hereby ordered to maintain the status quo of any Ferrari 375 Plus Grand Prix Roadster having Serial Number 0384AM or 0394AM ("Vehicles"), and all parts and documents related thereto ("Parts" and "Documents"), that are in said parties' respective possession, custody, or control. For purposes of this order, Vehicles shall mean any vehicle that is now, or has been at any time, identified as Serial Number 0384AM and/or Serial Number 0394AM. Parts shall mean any parts that are or ever were a part of, attached to, or related to the Vehicles. Documents shall mean title documents, registration documents, bill of sale documents, and any other type of ownership interest or ownership transfer document that relates to the Vehicles, Parts, or both.

All Parties specifically represent and affirm to the Court that, to the best of each of their respective knowledge and belief, they are the only persons claiming rights to,


holding interests in, and in possession of, the Vehicles, Parts, and/or Documents.

Except with prior written approval of this Court, the Parties shall not take any action that would disturb the status quo of the Vehicles, Parts, and/or Documents until a final determination of claims and ownership rights is made by this Court. Any reference herein to a vehicle with Serial Number 0394AM is not determinative of the issue as to whether there ever was a factory made Ferrari vehicle or Ferrari chassis with Serial Number 0394AM. Nothing in this order shall be determinative of the claims asserted in this matter or constitute an admission on the part of any party with respect to such claims.


